Journalism Training Grant

The Midwest Broadcast Journalists Foundation is seeking applicants to receive a \$500 grant to be used for professional journalism training. The winning applicant may use the grant to pay for training-related expenses, such as registration fees, tuition and/or travel expenses. Possible uses include graduate-level coursework in journalism, training programs offered by specialized providers such as the Poynter Institute or seminars produced by journalism associations (RTNDA, IRE, SPJ, etc.) and should be used within one calendar year of receiving the grant.

If entries merit, up to two \$500 grants will be awarded. Winner(s) will be announced in the spring during the MBJA Banquet at the Midwest Journalism Conference.
